

Note that your agreement to join AACR for the Broad Street Run here IS NOT an official registration for the race itself. Upon your acceptance of our fundraising terms and conditions, and at a time set by race organizers, AACR will complete the registration process for you. You will receive notification from the race organizers prior to the race when this process is complete. Your acceptance of AACR's fundraising terms, recommitment to said terms, and completion of the registration process within this campaign platform guarantees you a bib in the race.

**Fundraising Terms:** All AACR Runners for Research team members participating in the Independence Blue Cross Broad Street Run are responsible for raising a minimum of \$500 by the deadline of race day, May 3, 2026. In the event the participant does not meet the minimum fundraising requirement by the date outlined above, the American Association for Cancer Research (AACR) dba AACR Runners for Research will charge the balance owed to their credit card. Credit cards will not be charged if fundraising minimum is met. If participant has not reached the minimum in sponsorship by that date, they will be personally responsible for the balance owed and will ensure their credit card information provided is current and active to charge the remaining balance. If the fundraising minimum is not met and up-to-date credit card information is not provided, AACR reserves the right to pursue collection of the outstanding debt balance by any lawful means, including but not limited to third-party collection agencies or legal action. Participant will be fully responsible for all legal fees incurred with this collection process. If participant negates on their financial responsibility to AACR, they will be reported to the Broad Street Run organizers which may result in a ban from future Broad Street Run events. Fundraising deadline is May 3, 2026, unless otherwise stipulated by AACR Runners for Research manager and agreed to by participant.

**Recommitment:** All AACR Runners for Research team members participating in the Independence Blue Cross Broad Street Run must formally recommit to their race registration by March 15, 2026, through process communicated by AACR staff. Participant understands that by recommitting to the team, they will be responsible for meeting the \$500 fundraising minimum. All participants MUST complete this step to secure race registration. Should participant fail to recommit by March 15, AACR will not provide a race entry to participant and any registration fees and funds raised by participant will be retained by AACR. Once recommitted, participant is responsible for meeting the \$500 fundraising commitment regardless of injury or personal decision not to participate in the race.

**Cancellation Policy:** After notification of registration from Broad Street Run organizers, participant will be responsible for raising the stated minimum for the event even if participant chooses to cancel their participation for ANY reason.

**Donations and Fundraising:** Any donations received by the American Association for Cancer Research/AACR Runners for Research will not be returned. Matching gifts do not count towards the minimum under any circumstances.

**Release Agreement:** In consideration of accepting this entry, participant hereby for themselves, heirs, executors, and administrators, waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages they may have against the American Association for Cancer Research, AACR Runners for Research, and other foundation consultants and event sponsors for any and all injuries suffered or sustained in said event, in the training and planning sessions for said event, or travel to and from any of the preceding. Participant attests and certifies they are physically fit, will sufficiently train for competition in this event, and a licensed medical doctor can verify their physical condition if needed. Participant grants permission for use of their name and/or photograph or voice in broadcast, telecast, print, or any other account of this event.
